Program was a resound success.



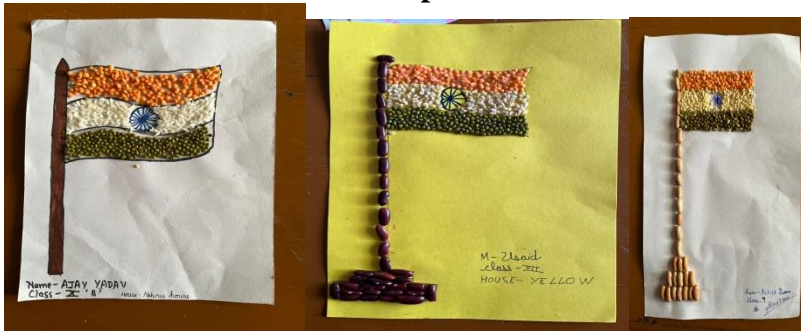
