The academic session **2025–2026** at De Vito School, Bhowali was marked by vibrant learning experiences, creativity, and active student-Teacher participation. The school continued its commitment to holistic education through a variety of engaging activities and events.

- ✓ With God's abundant blessings, we are successfully carrying on the work of De Vito School extension work which started on May 6th, 2025
- ✓ We, De Vito School, remain ever indebted to the Educational Society of the Maids of the Poor for their generous financial assistance for the extension of the school building, which will enable us to provide 4 laboratories and additional classrooms, wash rooms for boys and girls and mini Auditorium for multi-purpose activities.
- ✓ In collaboration with the Nagar Palika, we were able to repair and improve the road from Srivastava's washroom to the school gate, as well as carry out repairs/remaking of the road below the Old Block.
- ✓ For the 2025–2026 session, we were delighted to welcome new staff members: Sarika Singh as Computer Science teacher, Punit Arya as Music teacher, and Kavita Arya as Hindi teacher for the primary classes.
- ✓ Staff, students, parents, local shopkeepers, and well-wishers generously contributed toward the medical treatment of Karen Pandey of Class VIII, reflecting the strong spirit of unity and compassion in our community. Rs. One Lakh 75 thousands were hand over to his mother by Manager Tresia George.

Throughout the academic year 2025-2026 **special assemblies** were conducted on diverse and meaningful themes. These assemblies provided students with opportunities to enhance their public speaking skills, build confidence, and deepen their understanding of social, moral, and environmental issues. Themes included leadership, kindness, environmental awareness, health & wellness, cultural heritage, and value-based education. Academic Excellence

In the CBSE Board Examinations 2024–2025, 48 students of Class X appeared and all passed with good Percentage, Urshita securing the highest percentage 96%, while in the first CBSE Class XII batch, 27 students appeared and achieved commendable success, with Divayansi Rawat scoring the highest at 90%.

- Regular Class Tests on Mondays and Periodic Tests-1/11&111 were conducted.
- Half yearly and Annual Examinations -Pre-Board1&2 were held on schedule.
- Olympiad Examinations in all subjects were introduced this year to encourage competitive learning and academic excellence.
